Pool Rules

No lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.

Pool hours are:

6:00am to 10:00pm, Sunday through Thursday 6:00am to 12:00pm. Friday and Saturday

No running, horseplay, or unnecessary roughness in pool area.

No food, gum, or drinks allowed in or around the water.

No glass containers of any kind.

No diving, flips, or cartwheels off the side of the pool.

No hanging or playing on the pool ladders, shade structures, or other pool property.

No pets, bikes, scooters, skateboards, roller skates, or roller blades allowed in the pool area.

Only swimsuits may be worn in the water.

Children that are not potty trained must wear swim diapers in the pool. NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS.

Air inflatable toys and rafts may be used but not as flotation devices by a non-swimmer without adult supervision.

No smoking or alcohol in pool areas.

Radios and other noise should be maintained at a low level at all times.

Persons with skin diseases, open sores or wounds, inflamed eyes, nasal or ear infections, or any communicable diseases are not allowed to use the pool.

The Homeowners Association or Management Company is not responsible for accidents, injuries, or theft.

The pool phone should be used in case of emergency. If you have an emergency, call 911.

Vandalism will not be tolerated. To report vandalism, call the police immediately then notify the Management Company.
