

# POOL PARTY CLEANUP OR HOW DO I GET MY DEPOSIT BACK?

**The Golden Rule - Leave the pool and park area in the same condition or better than you found it.**

\_\_\_ **Trash must be gathered and disposed of away from both the pool and the park.** Bring your own trash bags and/or trashcans. There should be no more trash in the pool and park trashcans than there was when you arrived. You must remove all trash created by your party. Take it back to your house for curbside disposal on regular trash pick-up days.

\_\_\_ **Both swimming pools clear of party generated materials.** Check for pieces of paper, napkins, party favors, balloons, food, etc. All foreign objects from the party must be removed from the pool (*actually they should not have gotten there in the first place - food, beverages, paper and party products, as well as other items are only allowed on the pool deck and must be kept away from and out of both swimming pools*). Cleaning equipment is available upon request.

\_\_\_ **Pool Deck clean and free of party generated materials.** Food is a particular concern. If necessary, use the water hose at the pool to rinse the deck off away from the pool. All residue must be removed. Try walking around the deck bare foot to feel for any stickiness left by dropped food.

\_\_\_ **Pool furniture clean and placed in its original location.**

\_\_\_ **Bathrooms clean and free of party generated materials.** If the trashcans in the bathrooms are full, empty them.

\_\_\_ **Park area, pavilion, playground, and equipment clean and clear of party materials.** Do not assume your guests stayed inside the pool area. Trash from the party is not to be disposed of in the park trashcans (see first item above).

A member of the pool committee will inspect the pool and park areas one hour after the scheduled conclusion of your party (earlier if you desire). **The committee member should not be able to tell there ever was a party.** If the area passes inspection your deposit will be returned at that time.
